

Marriage 27 - Brissette, Jonathas and Ducharme, Celina:

On the 20th September, 1881, after the announcement of one ban of marriage, the omission of the two other bans and the second and third cousin relationship, having been considered and approved by the Most Reverend N.-B. Lorrain, Vicar General of the diocese of Montreal, on the 17th day of this September, between Jonathan Brissette, farmer, eldest son of Norbert Brisset and of Anastasie Carpentier of this parish on one part and Celina Ducharme, youngest daughter of the late Delphis Ducharme and Louis Brisset, also of this parish on the other part. The above mentioned, having come from the United States and having settled in this parish, and having discovered no objections to this marriage, and considering that the future bride is a minor, we the priest, and assigned pastor having received their mutual consent of marriage and having given them the nuptial blessing in the presence of Norbert Brisset father of the groom and of Gonzague Brisset, grandfather of the bride, who countersigned with us below.
